
IMPROVING COMMUNITY ACCESS

Online reporting system offers the public more options

The Charleston County Sheriff's Office, SC, has implemented an online reporting system to facilitate citizen generated incident reports. stated, The reporting system is now a permanent feature of the agency's public services. The Sheriff's Office will continue discussions on ways to improve community service and the employee workplace.

Deputies are still available to respond to these types of calls; however, this option is available for citizens who would rather file a report online. The incidents include:

- Breach of Trust (Under \$1000)
- Forgery
- Fraud
- Identity Theft
- Larceny (Under \$2000)
- Lost Property
- Vandalism (Under \$1000)
- Shoplifting (Past)
- Trespassing (Offender Not Present)
- Harassing Phone Calls (No Threats)
- Child Custody Dispute (Past)
- Civil Matter (Past)
