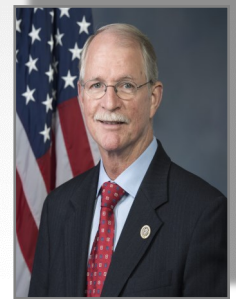


## **Senator (RI), Sheldon Whitehouse**

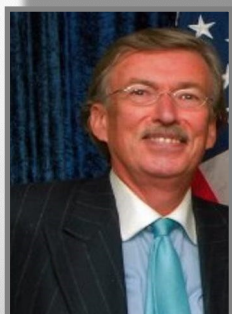


**Deputy Commissioner of Intelligence & Counterterrorism (NYPD),

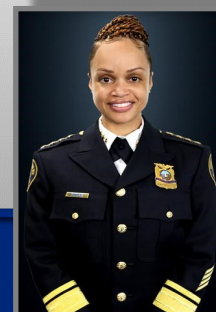


**President and CEO, Eisenhower Foundation, Alan Curtis**
