
MCCA President's Message

Senator (RI), Sheldon Whitehouse

Senator Sheldon Whitehouse (RI) was elected to the United States Senate on November 7, 2016. Senator Whitehouse is a member of the Budget Committee, the Environment and Public Works Committee (EPW), the Judiciary Committee, and the Finance Committee.

House Representative, John Rutherford

Representative John Rutherford is serving his second term in the U.S. House of Representatives where he represents Florida's 4th District. He sits on the House Appropriations Committee, where he serves on three subcommittees: Homeland Security; Military Construction and Veterans Affairs; and Transportation, Housing, and Urban Development. Prior to being elected to Congress, Rep. Rutherford served as Duval County Sheriff from 2003 to 2015.





Congressman, Bill Pascrell

Congressman Bill Pascrell, Jr. was first elected Congressman for New Jersey's 8th Congressional District in 1996. Bill is now service his twelfth term. He has built a life of public service upon the principles he learned while growing up on the south side of the Silk City. Bill's tenacity and dedication as a U.S. Congressman are marked by service to his constituents and his rise in leadership on issues critical to all Americans.

Deputy Director OC IAC, Alberto Martinez

Alberto Martinez is the Deputy Director and Analysis Supervisor for the Orange County Intelligence Assessment Center (CA), one of the 79 designated fusion centers across the United States and territories. Mr. Martinez is an Intelligence Analyst by training and currently serves as the Secretary for the National Fusion Centre Association (NFCA).





DHS Secretary, Kirstjen Nielsen

Kirstjen Michele Nielsen was sworn in on December 6, 2017 as the sixth Secretary of Homeland Security. She previously served as White House Deputy Chief of Staff. Secretary Nielsen joined the Trump administration in January 2017 as Chief of Staff to then-Secretary of Homeland Security, John Kelly.

FBI Director, Christopher Wray

Christopher Wray became the eighth Director of the FBI on August 2, 2017. In 2003, Director Wray was nominated by President George W. Bush to serve as Assistant Attorney General for the Criminal Division. In addition to overseeing criminal matters, Director Wray played a key role in the evolving national security mission of the Department.





COPS Director Phil Keith

Phil E. Keith has more than forty-seven years of experience in the fields of criminal justice, public safety, and business administration. He has held numerous high level policy making positions in law enforcement, public safety, and emergency management preparedness. He has thirty four years in active law enforcement service, with nearly seventeen years as Chief of Police for the Knoxville, Tennessee Police Department.

Executive Director NC HIDTA NCRIC, Mike Sena

Mike Sena is the Executive Director Northern California High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (NC HIDTA) Northern California Regional Intelligence Center (NCRIC). Executive Director Sena has had a diverse law enforcement career with the California Department of Alcoholic Beverave Control, the California Department of Justice, the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office, and the San Mateo County District Attorney's Office.



Acting Attorney General, Matthew Whitaker

Prior to becoming Acting Attorney General, Mr. Whitaker served as Chief of Staff to Attorney General Jeff Sessions. He was appointed as the U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of Iowa on June 15, 2004 by President George W. Bush.

The Deputy Commissioner for Intelligence and Counterterrorism oversees activities to both prevent and plan for a swift and efficient response in the event of a future terror attack in New York City.

Beth M. Huebner is a professor in the Department of Criminology and Criminal Justice at the University of Missouri-St. Louis. Her principal research interest include the collateral consequences of incarceration, racial and gender disparities in the criminal justice system, and public policy.




