Before coronavirus and the COVID-19 illness was declared a global pandemic, Major County Sheriffs of America was gathering information and marshalling experts to respond to this crisis. Through a series of weekly webinars cohosted by the National Commission on Correctional Health Care (NCCHC), major county sheriffs have had direct, live access to nationally-recognized epidemiologists, healthcare experts, and officials from the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC).

For the past six weeks, these weekly webinars have been focused on a different COVID-19 related topic – such as staff exposure, infrastructure concerns, population

such as Liesl Hagan of the CDC, Dr. Brent Gibson of NCCHC, Dr. Anne Spaulding of Emory University, Dr. Julia Wilson of Naphcare, and Dr. Brie Williams of the University of California San Francisco who have lent their professional insights from a clinical perspective.

Over 2,500 individuals have registered for these informational gatherings since their inception as they have become a reliable and engaging place to get information. Please join in on the conversation as we continue to hold these roundtables until the crisis has subsided.

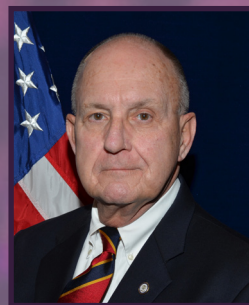
