We write to express our strong appreciation for extending the authorization of the Undetectable Firearms Act in the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2024.

As we discussed in our January 2024 letter, the Undetectable Firearms Act is critical to public safety as it makes it unlawful to manufacture or possess any firearm that is not detectable by a walk-through metal detector or x-ray machine. Since passing in 1988, the Act has been reauthorized multiple times with strong bipartisan support.

Your work to extend the authorization of the Undetectable Firearms Act will contribute to our national security mission as it ensures our public safety officials maintain the ability to detect threats in the most highly targeted areas and secure facilities across the country.
